2. <u>Procedure for Online Registration</u>

- (a) All candidates to log in to joinindianarmy.nic.in, check their eligibility status and create their profile.
- (b) Online Registration (submission of application) will commence from 13 February 2024 to 22 March 2024.
- (c) <u>Examination Fee</u>. Examination fee of Rs 250/- per applicant is to be paid by the candidate for the online examination. The candidate on successfully filling the application will be directed to SBI portal through a link on the website. At the SBI portal make payment of Rs 250/- plus Bank charges as applicable. The payment can be made through any of these payment options available:-
 - (i) Payment Gateway Facility through Maestro, Master Card, VISA, Rupay Cards both Credit & Debit of all major banks.
 - (ii) Internet banking of SBI and other banks.
 - (iii) UPI (Bhim)
- (d) Duplicate/Incomplete/Erroneously filled application will be rejected.
- (e) Candidates are required to have an active email & mobile number which will be used for further communication.
- (f) Candidates should apply only once in response to this notification.
- (g) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All Possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
- (h) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
- (j) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.
- (k) Candidate should enter AADHAR number in online application.

- 4. Candidates are advised to upload only recent colour photographs on JIA website. In case of uploaded photographs not matching with face, candidate will not be allowed to appear in the online CEE.
- 5. Candidates are to reach at the examination Centre <u>with colour print out of admit card</u>. Candidates shall be debarred from appearing in online test in case anomalies/irregularities / incorrect information are observed during initial verification at the examination venue or at any subsequent stage of selection process.
- 6. The candidates should carry his AADHAR Card (as displayed on the Admit Card) as proof of identity whenever they report for the Selection Test (Phase-I & II) and Medical Test.
- 7. Details about required educational qualification, physical/medical standards and job specification are available on www.joinindianarmy.nic.in under the candidate's login and this information can be accessed by the candidate without signing in.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

5. <u>Recruitment Process</u>. Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases. <u>Phase I</u> will be Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India and <u>Phase 2</u> will be Recruitment Rally by ZROs at Rally Venue.

Phase I

6. **Online CEE**.

- (a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/Email.
- (b) Candidates should download their Admit Card & carry a colour printout at the exam centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions.
- (c) Candidates are required to arrive at exam centre min 30 mins prior to reporting time as indicated on Admit Card.

- (d) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centre:-
 - (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.
 - (ii) Checking of Admit Card & Aadhaar Card at the checking point
 - (iii) Auto allotment of Exam Hall.
 - (iv) Attendance at Exam Hall gate.
 - (v) Capture of Biometric (Photo & thumb impression) inside the exam hall.
 - (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
 - (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
 - (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.
- (e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hr or 100 questions in two hrs.
- (f) Marking pattern for online test:-
 - (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% marks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (Negative marks).
- (g) Marks scored by the candidates in Online CEE will be normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.
- 7. Addl info for candidates till Phase I of the selection process:-
 - (a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All Possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.

Phase - II

- 8. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in written exam result. The Roll No of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of ZROs. The admit card for Phase II of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal https://joinindianarmy.nic.in. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following document /certificate in original alongwith two attested photocopies with them:-
 - (a) Admit Card. Colour printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
 - (b) <u>Photograph.</u> Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old Computerised/ photocopied/shopped photographs will **NOT** be accepted. Photographs must be with proper hair cut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates).

(c) Education Certificates.

- (i) Education Certificate with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/ Intermediate etc from recognized School/ College/ Board/ University.
- (ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer/ District Education Officer.
- (iv) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments / UT administrations is attach as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.
- (d) <u>Domicile Certificate</u>. Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.
- (e) <u>Caste Certificate</u>. Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.
- (f) Religion Certificate. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (if religion as "SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster where the candidates last studied.
- (h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch.
- (j) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates below the age of 21 years is required to be obtained with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months. (Format of unmarried certificate is attached as per Appendix 'F' with the Notification).
- (k) Relationship Certificate. Son of Servicemen (SOS), Son of Ex-servicemen (SOEX), Son of War Widow (SOWW) and Son of Widow of Ex-servicemen (SOW) candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concern Records.
 - (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'B'**.
 - (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

(I) NCC Certificate. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificates in original will only be accepted. No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/Sports/NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

(m) Sports Certificate.

- (i) Relaxation in physical standards is applicable to outstanding sportsmen as mentioned in Para 3 (a).
- (ii) <u>List of Sports</u>. List of Sports for enrolment is attached as <u>Appendix 'C'</u>.
- (n) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as perspecimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'D'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.
- (o) <u>Certificate for Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates/ photocopy duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks / Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.
- (p) PAN Card & AADHAAR Card. PAN Card & Aadhaar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.
- (q) Police Character Certificate.
- (r) Sarpanch/ Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof).

(s) Tattoo.

- (i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates: -
 - (aa) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates is attached as **Appendix 'E-I'**.
 - (ab) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo(s) to be signed by DC/DM or SDM of the District/ Tehsil where the tribe of the candidates is presently settled is attached as **Appendix 'E-II'** (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
- (ii) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

9. Candidates will be tested as stated below during the Phase II:-

- (b) <u>Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site)</u>. Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down Physical standards.
- (c) Adaptability Test. All candidates who qualify the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who will qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for medical & further recruitment process. Those candidates who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process. Candidates will be allowed to carry their Smart Phones for the duration of Adaptability Test.

(d) <u>Medical Examination</u>.

- (i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test, Physical Measurement Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.
- (ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within 5 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 07 days as per policy.
- (iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and med examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.
- (iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.

Note:

- 1. Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.
- 2. The above are **minimum prescribed standards and do not guarantee selection** as a right to candidates achieving them. Final selection will be based on over all merit position of the candidates.

10. Special Instructions

- (a) Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase –II, 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Offices for further clarification.
- (b) Candidate can apply in only one category. If anyone is found registered for multiple trade/ category, he will be disqualified and will not be considered for any trade/ category. Choose wisely before applying. For online registration & online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at AROs on working days from 1000 Hours to 1400 hours.
- (c) <u>01 October 2024</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class marksheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- (d) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by **0030 hours** on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after **0600 hours** without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. **Candidate should be clean shaven** (Except Sikh Candidate).
- (e) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instruction/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted with any other person. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. (ARO will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed).
- (f) Candidate must carry their AADHAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.
- (g) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.
- (h) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/Nativity/Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/District Magistrate.
- (j) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (k) <u>Touts</u>. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/means used by the touts are as under: -
 - (i) Issue of fake PFT Slips/impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.
 - (ii) Snatching/taking away original certificates from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them.
 - (iii) Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.
 - (iv) Giving candidates false assurance of "RECRUITMENT" as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of candidates.
 - (v) Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts, touts demand money in return of the original certificates.

- (I) A Grievance Cell will be established at the Rally Site to redress any grievances.
- (m) Candidates are requested to report at rally site with proper shave and hair cut so as to ensure proper identification & Medical Review.
- (n) Recruitment is purely based on merit depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim recruitment in Army for merely having passed in recruitment process.
- (o) Candidates not in possession of requisite certificates are liable for rejection.

Important Instructions

- 1. Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in, Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.
- 2. Recruitment into the army is fair and transparent. Candidates are advised not to pay bribe to anyone for recruitment as it is based purely on merit. - (f) Religion Certificate. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (if religion as "SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster where the candidates last studied.
- (h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch.
- (j) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for candidates below the age of 21 years is required to be obtained with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months. (Format of unmarried certificate is attached as per Appendix 'F' with the Notification).
- (k) Relationship Certificate. Son of Servicemen (SOS), Son of Ex-servicemen (SOEX), Son of War Widow (SOWW) and Son of Widow of Ex-servicemen(SOW) candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concern Records.
 - (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'B'**.
 - (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

(I) NCC Certificate. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificates in original will only be accepted. No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/Sports/NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

(m) **Sports Certificate.**

- (i) Relaxation in physical standards is applicable to outstanding sportsmen as mentioned in Para 3 (a).
- (ii) <u>List of Sports</u>. List of Sports for enrolment is attached as <u>Appendix 'C'</u>.

Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'D'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.

- (b) <u>Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site)</u>. Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down Physical standards.
- (c) Adaptability Test. All candidates who qualifies the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who will qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for medical & further recruitment process. Those candidate who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process. Candidates will be allowed to carry their Smart Phones for the duration of Adaptability Test.

(d) Medical Examination.

- (i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test and Physical Measurement Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.
- (ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within 5 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 07 days as per policy.
- (iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and med examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.
- (iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.

Note:

- 1. Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.
- 2. The above are **minimum prescribed standards and do not guarantee selection** as a right to candidates achieving them. Final selection will be based on over all merit position of the candidates.

10. Special Instructions

- (a) Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase –II, 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Offices for further clarification.
- (b) Candidate can apply in only one category. If anyone is found registered for multiple trade/ category, he will be disqualified and will not be considered for any trade/ category. Choose wisely before applying. For online registration & online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at AROs on working days from 1000 Hours to 1400 hours.
- (c) <u>01 October 2024</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class marksheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- (d) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by **0030 hours** on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after **0600 hours** without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. **Candidate should be clean shaven** (Except Sikh Candidate).
- (e) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instruction/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted with any other person. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. (ARO will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed).
- (f) Candidate must carry their AADHAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.
- (g) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.
- (h) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/Nativity/Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/District Magistrate.
- (j) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (k) <u>Touts</u>. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/means used by the touts are as under: -
 - (i) Issue of fake PFT Slips/impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.

- (a) Biometric identification and hand writing analysis will be done at each stage. Imposters will be caught and handed over to Police.
- (b) Use of any unfair means will make the candidate liable to disqualification at any stage of recruitment whenever found. He will be handed over to Police thereafter.
- (c) Military service is a volunteer service.
- 21. **Result of final merit will be declared on the official website joinindianarmy.nic.in**. No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to respective ARO/RO (HQ) for documentation.

- 13. <u>Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits</u>. AGNIVEER enrolled under this scheme will be paid an AGNIVEER package with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in Indian Army), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid.
- 14. <u>Terminal Benefits SevaNidhi Package</u>. AGNIVEER will be given onetime 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

NOTE: 1 AGNIVEER will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.

NOTE: 2 There shall be no entitlement to any gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits in case of AGNIVEER.

- 15. <u>Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation</u>. AGNIVEER will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of Rs 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIVEER in the Indian Army. AGNIVEER will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations/Rules for Indian Army.
- 16. <u>Agniveer Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set certificate will be provided to the AGNIVEER highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during their engagement period.
- 17. Personnel enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen Status.
- 18. Only unmarried candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveers and they must undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Agniveers who marry during the said period would be released from service. Further, only unmarried Agniveer will be eligible for re-enrolment in regular cadre as Sepoy/equivalent on selection as currently in vogue. Additionally, Women Agniveers would be required to undertake not to get pregnant during the engagement period. Such Women Agniveers on becoming LMC due to pregnancy are liable to be discharged /dismissed /released, as applicable, from service on administrative grounds post medical opinion.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

19. <u>Recruitment Process</u>. Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases. <u>Phase I</u> will be Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India and <u>Phase 2</u> will be Recruitment Rally by AROs at Rally Venue.

Phase I

20. Online CEE.

- (a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/Email.

 - (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
 - (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.
- (e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hr or 100 questions in two hrs.
- (f) Marking pattern for online test:-
 - (i) Full mks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil mks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% mks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (Negative marks).
 - (iv) All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.
- (g) Marks scored by the candidates in Online CEE will be normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.
- 21. Addl info for candidates till Phase I of the selection process:-
 - (a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All Possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - (d) In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the exam and the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

Phase - II

- 22. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in written exam result. The Roll No of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of ZROs. The admit card for Phase II of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal https://joinindianarmy.nic.in. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following document /certificate in original alongwith two attested photocopies with them:-
 - (a) Admit Card. Colour printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
 - (b) **Photograph**. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old Computerised/photocopied/shopped photographs will **NOT be accepted**.

(c) Education Certificates.

- (i) Education Certificate with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/Intermediate etc from recognized School/ College / Board/University.
- (ii) Provisional/online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/University.
- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer/ District Education Officer.
- (iv) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments / UT administrations is attach as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.
- (d) <u>Domicile Certificate</u>. Domicile Certificate with photograph issued by Tehsildar/ District Magistrate.
- (e) <u>Caste Certificate</u>. Caste Certificate affixed with photograph of the candidate issued by the Tehsildar/District Magistrate.
- (f) <u>Religion Certificate</u>. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (if religion as "SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (g) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/Headmaster where the candidates last studied.
- (h) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months from the date of despatch.
- (j) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for all candidates with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/Municipal Corporation within last six months. (Format of Unmarried Certificate is attached as per <u>Appendix 'F'</u> with the Notification).

- (k) Relationship Certificate. Daughter of Servicemen (DOS), Daughter of Ex-Servicemen (DOEX), Daughter of War Widow (DOWW), Daughter of Widow of Ex-Servicemen (DOW) candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concern Records.
 - (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the ESM duly signed by 1st Class/Executive/Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'B'**.
 - (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.
- (I) <u>NCC Certificate</u>. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificates in original will only be accepted. No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/Sports/NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.

(m) Sports Certificate.

- (i) Relaxation in physical standards is applicable to outstanding sportsmen as mentioned in Para 5 (b).
- (ii) List of Sports. List of Sports for enrolment is attached as Appendix 'C'.
- (n) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'D'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.

(s) Tattoo.

- (i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. - (b) Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site). Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down Physical standards.
- (c) Adaptability Test. All candidates who qualifies the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who will qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for medical & further recruitment process. Those candidates who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process. Candidates will be allowed to carry their Smart Phones for the duration of Adaptability Test.

(d) Medical Examination.

- (i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test and Physical Measurement Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.
- (ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to MH for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within 05 days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within 07 days as per policy.

- (iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and med examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.
- (iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.
- (v) <u>Gender</u>. Any candidate if found to have predominantly masculine characteristics evidenced on external physical examination, will be rejected as UNFIT. Any candidate having undergone gender reassignment surgery will be declared UNFIT.
- (vi) <u>Pregnancy</u>. Any female candidate, if found to be pregnant shall be disqualified and her candidature rejected. A candidate should not have conceived at the time of reporting, till conclusion of training at CMP Centre and School and during four years of engagement period as Agniveer. A Medical Certificate from a Government Medical Doctor (with minimum MBBS qualifications) stating the no pregnant status of a candidate will be produced on reporting for the recruitment rally, and a fresh certificate again, when reporting to the Training Centre, failing which the individual will be rejected summarily.

Note: Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

The above are **minimum prescribed standards and do not guarantee selection** as a right to candidates achieving them. Final selection will be based on over all merit position of the candidates.

24. Special Instructions

- (a) Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase –II, 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Offices for further clarification.
- (b) For online registration & online application, assistance will also be provided to candidates at AROs on working days from 1000 Hours to 1400 hours.
- (c) <u>01 October 2024</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class mark sheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- (d) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by **0600 hours** on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after **0800 hours** without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (e) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is **MUST**. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/Mobile Number like short listed/call letter/joining instruction/result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted with any other person. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. (ARO will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail / Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed).
- (f) Candidate must carry their AADHAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.
- (g) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/10th Class Board Certificate.

Candidates should make arrangement for stay under their own arrangements for three to four days. No candidate will be allowed to go out of the rally ground during the documentation/screening/medical tests.
- (b) Mobiles, tabs and calculators are not permitted at the rally site and during CEE except during adaptability test. Candidates must take care of their documents/belongings against theft during the rally.

20. Cautions for all Candidates.

- (a) Biometric identification and hand writing analysis will be done at each stage. Imposters will be caught and handed over to Police.
- (b) Use of any unfair means will make the candidate liable to disqualification at any stage of recruitment whenever found. He will be handed over to Police thereafter.
- (c) Military service is a volunteer service.
- 21. **Result of final merit will be declared on the official website joinindianarmy.nic.in**. No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to respective ARO/ RO (HQ) for documentation.

- (vi) In case a candidate is found to have made fake claims at any stage or furnished fake certificate to unfairly secure Bonus Marks, his candidature is liable to be cancelled at any stage of recruitment.
- (vii) In case any candidates achieves a higher class qualification certificate for bonus marks (i.e. NCC certificate & sports event certificate) between filling of online application & attending rally, such candidate will be awarded higher bonus marks on presenting original document at rally site during rally.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

5. AGNIVEER will be enrolled in the Indian Army under Indian Army Act 1950 for a period of four years. AGNIVEER would form a distinct rank in the Indian Army, different from any other existing ranks. Indian Army is not obliged to retain AGNIVEER beyond the engagement period of four years.

- 6. On completion of four years of service, based on organization's requirements and policies promulgated by the Indian Army, AGNIVEER will be offered an opportunity to apply for permanent enrolment in the Indian Army. These applications will be considered in a centralized manner based on objective criteria including performances during their four year engagement period and upto 25% of each specific batch of AGNIVEER will be enrolled in regular cadre of Indian Army. AGNIVEER will not have any right to be selected for further enrolment into the Indian Army. Selection of the AGNIVEER for further enrolment, if any, shall be at the discretion of the Indian Army.
- 7. **Employability**. AGNIVEER enrolled under this entry are liable to be assigned any duty in organizational interest, at the discretion of the Indian Army.
- 8. <u>Training</u>. On being enrolled, AGNIVEER will be imparted military training based on Indian Army requirement.
- 9. <u>Leave</u>. Grant of leave will be subject to exigencies of Indian Army. The following leave may be applicable for Agniveer during their engagement period :-
 - (a) **Annual Leave**: 30 days per year.
 - (b) **Sick Leave**: Based on medical advice.
- 10. <u>Medical and CSD Facilities</u>. For the duration of their engagement period in Indian Army, AGNIVEER will be entitled for medical facility at Service Hospitals as well as CSD provisions.
- 11. <u>Pay, Allowances and Allied Benefits</u>. AGNIVEER enrolled under this scheme will be paid an AGNIVEER package with a fixed yearly increment. In addition, Risk and Hardship allowances (as applicable in Indian Army), Dress and Travel allowances will be paid.
- 12. <u>Terminal Benefits Seva Nidhi Package</u>. AGNIVEER will be given onetime 'Seva Nidhi' package comprising their monthly contribution with matching contribution by the Government on completion of their engagement period, as indicated below:-

NOTE: 1 AGNIVEER will not be required to contribute to any Provident Fund of the Government.

NOTE: 2 There shall be no entitlement to any gratuity and any kind of pensionary benefits in case of AGNIVEER.

13. <u>Insurance, Death and Disability Compensation</u>. AGNIVEER will be provided non-contributory life insurance cover of Rs 48 lakhs for the duration of their engagement period as AGNIVEER in the Indian Army. AGNIVEER will not be governed by provisions contained in the Pension Regulations/ Rules for Indian Army.

- 14. <u>Agniveer Skill Certificate</u>. At the end of engagement period, a detailed Skill-Set certificate will be provided to the AGNIVEER highlighting the skills and level of competency acquired by the personnel during **their engagement period**.
- 15. Personnel enrolled under this Scheme will not be eligible for Ex-Servicemen Status.
- 16. Only unmarried candidates will be eligible for enrolment as Agniveers and they must undertake not to marry during the defined engagement period of four years. Agniveers who marry during the said period would be released from service. Further, only unmarried Agniveers will be eligible for re-enrolment in regular cadre as Sepoy/equivalent on selection as currently in vogue.

SEQUENCE OF RECRUITMENT

- 17. Recruitment Process. Recruitment process will be conducted in two phases :-
 - (a) Phase I. Online Common Entrance Exam at Computer Based Test Centres spread pan India.
 - (b) Phase II. Recruitment Rally by Army Recruiting Office, Muzaffarpur at Rally Venue.

PHASE - I : ONLINE COMMON ENTRANCE EXAM

18. Online CEE.

- (a) Candidates can download Admit Card after clicking the link on Join Indian Army website. Candidate has to put his user name (which is the Roll Number of candidate) and Password as received by SMS/ Email.
- (b) Candidates should download their Admit Card & carry a colour printout at the exam centre. All instructions given on Admit Card must be read by the candidates carefully and they should adhere to the instructions.
- (c) Entry gates at exam centre will be opened one and a half hour prior to scheduled time of exams and will close, 30 minutes prior to time of exam. No candidate will be allowed to enter once the entrance gate is closed.
- (d) No electronic gadgets are permitted at the examination centres. Candidates will undergo following activities at the exam centres:-
 - (i) Frisking at Entry Gate.
 - (ii) Checking of Admit Card & Aadhar Card at the checking point.
 - (iii) Auto allotment of Exam Hall.
 - (iv) Attendance at Exam Hall gate.
 - (v) Capture of Biometric (Photo & thumb impression) inside the exam hall.
 - (vi) Login ID to allotted computer terminal.
 - (vii) Appear for test as per procedure.
 - (viii) Exit Biometric before exiting the Examination Hall.
- (e) Online test will be objective Multiple Choice Question (MCQ). As per category of application, the candidates would be required to answer 50 questions in one hour or 100 questions in two hours.

- (f) Marking pattern for online test :-
 - (i) Full marks for every correct answer.
 - (ii) Nil marks for unattempted question.
 - (iii) 25% marks shall be deducted for every attempted wrong answer (-ve marks).
 - (iv) All questions, if attempted, will be considered for evaluation, even if marked for review.
- (g) <u>Typing Test for Agniveer Office Asst/SKT</u>. Typing test for candidates appearing for Agniveer Office Asst/SKT will be carried out during the online CEE wherein 30 words per min (wpm) in English during the test is desirable. Only those candidates who qualify the typing test will be eligible for call up for Phase-II of recruitment process.
- (h) Marks scored by the candidates in Online CEE will be Normalised to take into account variation in difficulty levels of the question paper across different sessions.
- 19. Additional information for candidates till Phase-I of the selection process:-
 - (a) Candidates must indicate five choices of the exam centre. All possible effort would be taken to allot exam centre based on first three choices.
 - (b) Request for change of exam centre or date of selection test will not be entertained.
 - (c) Candidates not reporting for the test on due date & time will not be accommodated on other dates.
 - (d) In case any candidate is found using unfair means, the candidate will not be allowed to complete the exam and the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

PHASE - II : RECRUITMENT RALLY BY ARMY RECRUITING OFFICE

- 20. Proportionate to the vacancies available candidates would be shortlisted by applying a cut off in **Online Common Entrance Exam** result. The Roll Number of the candidates who are in merit will be published on Join Indian Army website. These candidates will receive a second admit card for balance of recruitment process as per Rally Schedule of **Army Recruiting Office**, **Muzaffarpur**. The admit card for Phase-II of recruitment process can also be downloaded online under candidate's login (profile) on Join Indian Army web portal www.joinindianarmy.nic.in. Shortlisted candidates have to report on the stipulated date and time for Phase-II at the designated Recruitment Rally venue with following documents/ certificates in original alongwith two attested photocopies with them:-
 - (a) Admit Card. Printed on Laser Printer on good quality paper (Do not shrink the size).
 - (b) <u>Photograph</u>. Twenty (20) copies of unattested Passport size colour photographs developed on good quality photographic paper in white background not more than three months old Computerised/ photocopied/ shopped photographs will **NOT** be accepted. Photographs must be with proper haircut and clean shave (except Sikh Candidates).

(c) Education Certificates.

- (i) Education Certificate with marks sheet of all educational qualifications achieved by candidate i.e Matric/ Intermediate etc from recognized School/ College/ Board/ University.
- (ii) Provisional/ online education certificate should be certified in ink signed by the head of the educational institution of concerned Board/ University.

- (iii) Candidates with matric certificate from Open School should bring School Leaving Certificate countersigned by Block Education Officer (BEO)/ District Education Officer (DEO).
- (iv) List of Education Board recognized by State Governments/ UT administrations is attached as **Appendix 'A'** will only be accepted.
- (d) For 8th Class Pass Candidates. 8th class pass mark sheet and transfer certificate issued by school (both certificate) should be countersigned by District Inspector of School/ District Education Officer.
- (e) <u>Domicile Certificate</u>. Domicile Certificate generated online through Government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/ Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from government website will only be acceptable (**No Tatkal Domicile certificate will be acceptable**).
- (f) <u>Caste Certificate.</u> Caste Certificate of the candidate generated online through government website and digitally signed by Circle Officer and countersigned by SDO/Tehsildar/ District Magistrate which can be verified from government website will only be acceptable. For Adivasi, the caste certificate should be issued by District Magistrate only.
- (g) Religion Certificate. Religion Certificate to be issued by the Tehsildar/ SDM (if religion as "SIKH/ HINDU/ MUSLIM/ CHRISTIAN" is not mentioned in caste certificate).
- (h) <u>School Character Certificate</u>. School Character Certificate issued by the School/College Principal/ Headmaster where the candidates last studied.
- (j) <u>Character Certificate</u>. Character Certificate with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months. **Certificate issued by Mukhiya will not be acceptable**. Character certificate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.
- (k) <u>Character Certificate Issued by SSP/ SP Office</u>. Character Certificate duly affixed with individual's photograph issued digitally by SSP/ SP office of district concerned within last six months which can be verified from government website. Character certificate without photo attested by certificate issuing authority will be rejected.
- (I) <u>Unmarried Certificate</u>. Unmarried Certificate for all candidates with photograph issued by Village Sarpanch/ Municipal Corporation within last six months. Certificate issued by Mukhiya will not be acceptable. Format of Unmarried certificate is attached as per <u>Appendix 'B'</u>.
- (m) Relationship Certificate. SOS/SOEX/SOW/SOWW Candidates are required to produce the following documents:-
 - (i) Relationship certificate issued from respective Record Office only duly signed by Record Officer with Personal Number, Rank, Name and particular of the Record Officer issuing the Relationship Certificate with office seal/ stamp is endorsed. Relationship certificate should bear water marks of the concern Records.
 - (ii) A declaration to the effect as mentioned in Affidavit on Ten Rupees Non-Judicial Stamp paper prepared by the Ex-Servicemen (ESM) duly signed by 1st Class/ Executive/ Judicial Magistrate is required to be submitted by the candidate at rally site. **Format of affidavit is attached as per Appendix 'C'**.
 - (iii) Original Discharge Book of Ex-Servicemen also to be produced. Name and date of birth of the candidate must have been recorded in it.

- (n) <u>NCC Certificate</u>. NCC A/B/C Certificate and Republic Day Parade certificate should have photograph of the candidate duly attested by issuing authority. NCC A/B/C pass certificates in original will only be accepted. No bonus marks in the final merit to be allotted unless the certificate (Relationship/ Sports/ NCC) have been verified. An undertaking to the effect will be obtained from the candidate.
- (o) <u>Affidavit</u>. Duly signed by candidate on Rs 10/- Non-Judicial Stamp Paper as per specimen duly attested by notary will be submitted by candidate at the Rally Site without fail. Format of affidavit attached as per <u>Appendix 'D'</u>. Submission of Affidavit is Mandatory to gain entry into the Rally. Candidates WILL NOT BE PERMITTED to enter the rally without affidavit.
- (p) <u>Certificate of Bonus Marks</u>. All original certificates/ photocopies duly attested pertaining to Bonus marks will be accepted only during the Rally. No certificates to include NCC Certificates, Sports Certificate, Relationship Certificate or any other certificates to claim Bonus Marks/ Relaxation would be accepted after termination of the Rally.
- (q) PAN Card & AADHAR Card. PAN Card & Aadhar Card are mandatory documents for final enrolment for the purpose of Pay & allowances and other social benefits scheme.
- (r) Sarpanch/Nagar Sewak (Residence Proof).

(s) Tattoo.

- (i) Candidates belonging to tribal communities/ from tribal areas, are permitted to have permanent body tattoos on any part of the body, as per existing customs and traditions of the said tribe to which a candidate belongs. Such candidates will only be permitted on producing the following two certificates: -
 - (aa) Self certification certificate to be signed by the candidates is attached as **Appendix 'E-I**'.
 - (ab) Certificate of belonging to a tribal community and permissibility of permanent Body Tattoo(s) to be signed by DC/ DM or SDM of the District/ Tehsil where the tribe of the candidates is presently settled is attached as **Appendix 'E-II'** (Name and designation of the concerned official must be clearly mentioned).
- (ii) Permanent body tattoos of religious sentiment are only permitted on inner face of forearms i.e from inside of elbow to the wrist and on the reverse side of palm/back (dorsal) side of hand. Permanent body tattoos on any other part of the body are not acceptable and candidates will be barred from further selection.

<u>Note</u>: Candidates are strongly advised to carry all documents at rally site on the day of their physical test & documentation check. No certificate will be accepted during or after the rally except for the nominated day.

Note: Candidates appearing for Agniveer Technical and Agniveer Office Asst/ SKT only need to qualify in all tests.

- (b) Physical Measurement Test (At Rally Site). Physical measurement will be carried out as per the laid down Physical standards listed at Para 1 above.
- (c) Adaptability Test. All candidates who qualifies the Physical Fitness Test (PFT) & Physical Measurement Test (PMT) will have to undertake Adaptability Test as per policy in vogue. Adaptability Test is for selection of candidates who can adapt to the environment of the Indian Army and are able to adapt to the challenges of military life. Those candidates who will qualify the Adaptability Test will be eligible for medical & further recruitment process. Those candidate who do not qualify the Adaptability Test will not be allowed for further participation in recruitment process. Candidates will be allowed to carry their Smart Phones for the duration of Adaptability Test.

(d) Medical Examination.

- (i) Medical examination of candidates who qualify in Physical Fitness Test, Physical Measurement Test and Adaptability Test will be conducted by Army Medical Team at the Rally site as per Army Medical standards and policy in vogue on the subject issue.
- (ii) Unfit candidates will be referred to Military Hospital for specialist review. Candidates to report to designated Military Hospital within five days from referral and review medical exam to be completed by Military Hospital within seven days as per policy.
- (iii) The recruitment medical officer and the specialist doctors of Armed Forces are the final authorities on declaring a candidate fit or unfit during initial med examination, review medical examination and medical examination prior to enrolment. The candidates shall be governed by Army standards which may be at variance from civil standards. There is no provision for representation or appeal or re-review after the review medical examination.
- (iv) Passing in the medical examination is not a guarantee for employment in Indian Army.

<u>Note</u>: Candidates discharged from the Indian Armed Forces for any reason are not eligible to appear in the selection test.

22. Important Instructions.

- (a) Any candidate who has not received admit card for Phase-II, 05 days prior to the Rally, may approach Army Recruiting Office, Muzaffarpur for further clarification.
- (b) <u>01 October 2024</u> will be taken as effective date of determining age eligibility for candidate. Candidates to produce birth certificate/10th class mark sheet at the time of preliminary document check.
- (c) Candidates are required to report at the Rally Site by **0200 AM** hours on their respective scheduled dates. Candidates reporting after 0600 hours without appropriate justification will not be permitted to participate in the Rally. **Candidate should be clean shaven** (Except Sikh Candidate).
- (d) Personnel e-mail ID and Mobile Number is MUST. All important messages will be sent to this e-mail ID/ Mobile Number like shortlisted/ call letter/ joining instruction/ result etc. Sharing of e-mail ID and Mobile Number is not permitted. Remember the User Name and Password for future use. **Army Recruiting Office, Muzaffarpur** will not be responsible for not getting required information if e-mail/ Mobile Number of candidates given is wrong/ changed.
- (e) Candidate must carry their AADHAR Card as proof of identity which could be authenticated biometrically at the Rally Site. Candidates to ensure AADHAR details are matching with the details mentioned in the documents and the Online Application.
- (f) Candidate's Name, Father's Name, Mother's Name and DOB must be entered exactly as per Matriculation/ 10th Class Board Certificate.
- (g) Candidate must enter contact details and permanent home address exactly as per Domicile/ Nativity/ Permanent Residential Certificate issued by Sub Divisional Magistrate/ District Magistrate. Candidates participating in different rallies using **multiple nativity** certificates will be rejected under fraudulent enrolment and will be liable for legal action in addition to rejection of candidature.
- (h) Those not in possession of required documents will not be permitted to participate in the Rally.
- (j) <u>Malpractices</u>. Recruitment into the Army is fair, transparent and is based purely on merit. Selection process during recruitment at all stages is automated. Advisory for candidates is as under:-
 - (i) <u>Touts</u>. In the past, a number of candidates have been found victims of touts, fake documents/ impersonation and in the bargain have lost their candidature. Modus operandi/ means used by the touts are as under:-
 - (aa) Issue of fake PFT Slip/ impersonation during various stages of rally. Conduct fake recruitment rallies.
 - (ab) Snatching/ taking away original certificates from candidates who have been declared fit at initial stage and thereafter harassing them.
 - (ac) Taking away "ADMIT CARD" from the candidates under plea that they will follow up their results.
 - (ad) Giving candidates false assurance of RECRUITMEN as they claim to have links at appropriate level, thereby winning confidence of candidates.
 - (ae) Once a candidate gets through on his own efforts, touts demand money in return of the original certificates.

- (ii) <u>Bribes</u>. Giving/ taking bribe, production of bogus/ fake certificates and indulging in unfair means is a criminal offence and liable for punishment under law. Such candidates will be handed over to Civil Police and their candidature cancelled.
- (k) A Grievance Cell will be established at the Rally Site to redress any grievances.
- (I) Recruitment is purely based on merit depending on available vacancies. Candidates do not have any right to claim recruitment in Army for merely having passed in recruitment process.

(m) Admit Card.

- (i) Candidates will be permitted entry into the rally site only on production of Admit Card in duplicate generated online through the official website www.joinindianarmy.nic.in, Anyone found with fake admit card will be handed over to Civil Police.
- (ii) Candidates to come for the rally only on the date as per Admit Card. Candidates should bring pen, handkerchief.
- (n) Candidates are advised to check their age & education criteria before participating in the rally. Candidates found under age/ overage and not meeting education criteria will be disqualified.
- (o) Certificates with overwriting and tampering of seals or erasing/ alteration of any type will not be accepted.
- (p) All documents submitted by the candidates are verified by government agencies before enrolment into Army. Strong legal action will be taken against individuals submitting fake documents. Even after recruitment, the service will be terminated if candidates are found to have produced fake documents or gave wrong information at the time of recruitment, despite the number of years of service individual may have rendered.
- (q) No compensation for Death/ Injury/ loss etc during the rally and no travelling allowance/ dearness allowance for journey is admissible. Candidates will participate in the rally at their own risk and the participation is totally and entirely voluntary. The signing of Indemnity Bond is a mandatory requirement. **Format is attached as Appendix 'F'**.
- (r) <u>Use of Performance Enhancing Drugs</u>. Use of any kind of performance enhancing drugs is strictly banned. Any candidate found in possession of or to have used the same will be debarred from further screening. Format is attached as Appendix 'G'.
- (s) Selection is provisional till they report to the allotted Regimental/ Corps Training Centre for training and their enrolment form is filled.
- (t) At the rally site, all candidate should report duly shaved (beard, chest hair, axillary hair, pubic hair) and with crew haircut (except Sikh Candidates), for identification at various stages of rally process failing which candidate can be barred from participation in recruitment rally.
- (u) Candidates may have to present themselves at rally site for two to three times. Candidates should make arrangements for stay under their own arrangements.

(v) Medical.

- (i) Candidates are advised in their own interest to undergo medical exam before coming for selection especially with respect to flat foot, poor vision, deformities and physical measurements. All are advised to ensure that their ears are free of wax by getting it cleaned by a doctor prior to the rally.
- (ii) If 180 days or more lapse between screening medical at the rally and despatch, medical will be done again and unfit candidates in this review will not be recruited.
- (iii) No use of contact lenses.
- (w) Final Result will be declared on the official website <u>joinindianarmy.nic.in</u>. No separate letter will be sent to the candidate. It is responsibility of candidate to check his result and report to **Army Recruiting Office**, **Muzaffarpur** for despatch formalities.
- (x) <u>Footwear</u>. 1.6 Km run may take place on Road/ Hard surface due to weather condition. All candidates are advised to use suitable running footwear (Shoes) for 1.6 Km run and practice accordingly for the rally.
- (y) Smartphone will be permitted during Adaptability Test only. Phone should be adequately charged and should have atleast 2GB data.
- (z) <u>Administration</u>. Candidates are advised to bring sufficient eatables and drinking water with them since recruitment is a time consuming process.
